- While levels are divided as we are used to seeing them, we would like to use every spot available rather than turn a skater away. We may reach out to people in a 1 level up/down as we see where the needs are, please be flexible if you can as we try to accommodate everyone this year[©]
- The Freeskate 1 being on both the Badge Session and Low Session is not a mistake. We understand that some skaters fresh out of Pre-Freeskate may be overwhelmed by a 4 day package and wanted to give them the opportunity to remain on the ice and experience an open session and private instruction, while others may have been on a junior session all year and are used to skating that many days a week.
- Parents may need to sign up to play music to avoid skaters clustered around the CD player. ** There are 2 heaters in the music box.
